 account of the activities taken up during the specified period only, and the report should not
 exceed 20 (twenty) pages in 1.5 line spacing in Times New Roman font 12, including some
 important photos.

- Rural and community development activities.
- Educational activities Programmes for schools and colleges.
- Healthcare and Blood Donation camps, associating some NGOs and hospitals Training small and Tiny Enterprise owners and managers
- Visits to hospitals, old-age homes, orphanages and prisons
- Public and Student Awareness activities related to scholarships, road safety, RTI and so on
- Sports, including 2k or 5k run with other Colleges.
- Any other activity thought to be of use to public and students.
