In this regard, it is proposed to conduct an open competition on designing of LOGO for ALHW on account of Golden Jubilee Year 2015 celebrations. Interested persons are invited to participate and submit the same to the department upto 22.09.2015 as per the following details and terms and conditions.


Overview of the Contest: Logo should relate and depict to the activities carried out by ALHW. ALHW has created Wharves, artificial harbours by construction of Rubble Mound Breakwaters with jetties and allied facilities, inter-island jetties and innumerable ferry jetties, Dry Dock/Slipway Complex at Port Blair for repairs of Inter Island ships and other ferry boats. Procurement and commissioning of Cargo handling equipments which includes wharf cranes, forklifts, Reach stacker, Coles Crane etc. Andaman Lakshadweep Harbour Works (ALHW) has already entered into 50 years of its existence.

Eligibility: The contest is open to all. The Contest is eligible to employees of the ALHW and their immediate families (parents, siblings, children and spouse). The contest is limited to the participants of India only. Contestants name, mobile number, email address and postal address shall be submitted. Online contestants may attached files in A4 size 297 x 210 mm, resolution must be in 300 dpi\ JPEG format, 595 x 841 pixels. Limit attachment size to not more than 10Mb.

- Modern, simple, smart, recognizable, memorable
- Design must be your own original unpublished work and must not contain third-party logos, trademarks or copyright materials
- Logo must include the word, "ALHW" and motto as "Service to Islands"
- Have agreed to the Terms and Conditions which can be found on the departmental web site.

About ALHW

The Andaman Lakshadweep Harbour Works (ALHW) was set up by the Ministry of Shipping in October 1965 and entrusted with the responsibility of formulating and implementing the Programmes of the Government for providing Ports and harbour structures including allied facilities in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep. A well-knit and coordinated Port / Shipping system play an important role in the sustained growth of the Islands. The need for Ports became more pronounced in these Islands in view of the accelerated developmental programs proposed by the Government during the sixties. The infrastructure, therefore, had to be fully planned properly and in advance. The history of Port development in these Islands dates back to as early as 1956 when experts in port technology visited the Islands. The recommendations of these experts have laid the foundation for development of port facilities by the Andaman Lakshadweep Harbour Works in later years.

The ALHW has been implementing Port Development schemes from the Third Five Year Plan onwards. All the works taken up under these plans have been completed in time and being maintained and operated successfully. Reviewing the Port Development Schemes implemented in A & N Islands so far, this department has created artificial harbours at Hut Bay of Little Andaman, Carnicobar, Campbell Bay of Great Nicobar and Rangat Bay of Middle Andaman by construction of Rubble Mound Breakwaters with jetties/wharves and allied facilities. Further, in the other natural harbours of the Islands, a number of inter-

island jetties and innumerable ferry jetties have also been completed in addition to the New Dry Dock / Slipway Complex at Port Blair for repairs of Inter Island ships and other ferry boats. In respect of Lakshadweep, jetties have been constructed in all the 10 islands and the approach channels dredged and navigational aids provided. Sheltered harbour basins were created at Androth and Kalpeni Islands with Breakwater and wharf for berthing passenger ships and cargo barges having up-to 4m and 1.8 M draughts respectively. In addition to above, eastern side embarkation

The ALHW is headed by the Chief Engineer & Administrator and has five Circles in A&N Islands and one Circle in Lakshadweep. The Headquarter office of the ALHW was shifted to Port Blair from New Delhi in May 1984.

The ALHW, in the past 48 years has constructed various harbour facilities in the major islands as per the requirements in a phased manner after conducting detailed hydrographic surveys at site, model studies & experiments at Central Water and Power Research Station, Pune and other consultants such as Indian Institute of Technology, National Institute of Ocean Technology, Chennai, NEERI Nagpur, NIO Goa etc.

Eligibility

Open to all Indians. Please refer to this link to check ALHW web site " www.alhw.and.nic. The Contest is also eligible to employees of ALHW and their immediate families (parents, siblings, children and spouse) and persons living in the same household (whether related or not). The Contest is only available in India and no other countries. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify entries that do not meet the eligibility terms and conditions of the Contest.

Duration of Contest

The Contest begins at 0830 hrs. on 25th August 2015 to 25th September 2015 and will continue until such time as the Organizer, in its sole and absolute discretion, elects to terminate the Contest. The Organizer reserve the right to shorten, extend, modify, terminate, or cancel the Contest, at its discretion, at any time. The Organizer reserves the right to modify any of the Terms and Conditions set forth herein. All artworks received after 1700 hrs. of the 25th September 2015 will be considered void/ unsuccessful.

All artworks are to be submitted as an individual / Association. Participants are allowed to submit a maximum of one entry. The Contest is free of charge for the participants.
