Amity Law School, Delhi has been organising the Annual National Moot Court Competition every year for the last 15 years. In continuance with our tradition, we are pleased to announce the 16th edition to be held from from 3rd March to 5th March, 2017.

The moot problem is based on concepts of Constitutional Law and Criminal Procedure. The competition will seek to integrate practical and legal insight and the spirit of teamwork amongst the participating students. The venue is Amity Law School, P-1 Block, Amity University Campus, Sector-125, Noida – 201303.

Eligibility & Team Composition: All leams shall consist of a maximum of three participants (two members designated as 'Speaker' and one member designated as Researcher), enrolled as full-time LL.B. students (both 3 year and 5 year programme) in the law school they represent at the time of the Competition. No person enrolled in a postgraduate law programme may act as a team member. A team must consist of at least two participants in which case both the members shall be designated as 'Speakers'.
