

Poster Design Competition for Accessible India Campaign

Technical Parameters for Poster Design

1) Participants should upload poster design in JPEG/PDF format only

2) The poster should be designed on a digital platform. The winner of the competition shall be required to submit the design in an editable and open file format.

3) Participants should not put any imprints or watermarks on the poster.

4) A small description should be provided to explain the concept.

5) The logo should be clearly visible when used in 10 mm size (for use on letterheads) and if required, can be enlarged to hoarding size.

6) Poster should be designed using colors (Not greyscale or black and white sales).

7) The poster should be usable on the website/social media such as Twitter/Facebook and on printed material such as b/w press releases, stationery and signage.

Prizes:

1) Best Entry – General – INR10,000

- 2) Best Entry -Making Buildings Accessible INR10,000
- 3) Best Entry- Making ICT Accessible INR10,000
- 4) Best Entry- Making Transport Accessible INR10,000

Evaluation Criteria

 All the entries received by DEPwD would be assessed for award by the Selection Committee. Entries would be judged on the basis of elements of creativity, originality, composition, technical excellence, simplicity, artistic merit and visual impact and how well they communicate the theme of the scheme. The decision of the Selection Committee would be final and binding on all the contestants and no clarifications would be issued to any participants for any or their decisions.

Terms and Conditions

- The competition is open to all citizens of India only.
- The winning design would be the intellectual property of the Government of India and the winner cannot exercise any right over it, after acceptance of the prize. The prize winning design is meant to be used by Government of India for promotional and display purpose, IEC material and also for any other use as may be deemed appropriate for the initiative.



- The decision of DEPwD on selection of winners and prize shall be treated as final. No copying will be allowed.
- The disqualified entries shall not be used by DEPwD for any purpose and DEPwD shall have no intellectual rights over the same.
- Any legal proceedings arising out of the competition/its entries/winners shall be subject to local jurisdiction of Delhi State.
- The design must not contain any provocative, objectionable or inappropriate content.
- Multiple submissions of design by the same participant would not be considered.
- The participant must be the same person who has designed the entry.
- Please note that the design must be original and should not violate any provision of the India Copyright Act, 1957. No plagiarism will be tolerated. Anyone found infringing on others'copyright would be disqualified from the competition. Government of India does not bear any responsibility for copyright violations or infringements of intellectual property carried out by the participants.
- The employees of DEPwD as well as their family members are not allowed to take part in this competition.
- Participant is to make sure that his/her MyGov profile is accurate and updated since DEPwD would be using this for further communication. This includes details such as name, photo and phone number. Entries with incomplete profiles would not be considered.
- DEPwD reserves the right to cancel or amend all or nay part of the Contest and/or the Terms & Conditions/Technical Parameters/Evaluation Criteria. However, any changes to the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/Evaluation Criteria, or cancellation of the Contest, will be updated/posted on the MyGov platform. It would be the responsibility of the participants to keep themselves informed as to any changes in the Terms & Conditions/Technical Parameters/Evaluation Criteria stated for this contest.
