### 'Capture Bagalkot' - International Photography Competition

In the backdrop of the Badami Heritage Festival an International Photography Competition 'Capture Bagalkot' is being organised by Catalytic Think Tank Forum. Catalytic is on quest to evolve a 'Bagalkot District Strategic Development Plan 2020'. Various initiatives to boost tourism in the district which mainly revolves around Badami, Pattadakkal, and Aihole are being taken up. Electronic submission of maximum 3 photographs.

#### **Terms and Conditions:**

- Registration fees of Rs.500/- payable by cheque, DD in the name of 'Catalytic Think Tank Forum, Bangalore'
- 2. Images are to be uploaded to the competition website by 30<sup>th</sup> November 2015. No late entries accepted.
- 3. Entrants can submit maximum of 3 images for Competition/Exhibition.
- 4. Photographs must be in digital format. The photograph need not be taken with a digital camera; scans of negatives, transparencies, or photographic prints are acceptable. All digital files must be 5 megabytes or smaller, must be only in JPEG or JPG format, and should not exceed 2,500 pixels on the longer side.
- 5. Images should not be Photo-shopped. Please submit photographs that are unmanipulated and real, and that capture those special moments in time. We want to see Bagalkot District through your eyes, not the tools of Photoshop or setup photography. Please do not digitally enhance or alter your photographs (beyond the basics needed to achieve realistic color balance and sharpness). If you have digitally added or removed anything, please don't submit the shot. We look at every photo to see if it's authentic, and if we find that yours is in any way deceptive, we'll disqualify it. In case of the winners, we will ask for the RAW files, if available, to be submitted for review. DODGING AND BURNING: Dodging (to brighten shadows) or burning (to darken highlights) is fine, but please don't overdo it. Your goal in using digital darkroom techniques should be to adjust the dynamic tonal range of an image so that it more closely resembles what you saw.

COLOR SATURATION: Just as with dodging and burning, your goal should be to make it real. Please avoid significant over- or under-saturation. A lot of photographers make the mistake of over-saturating color, making their images look cartoonish.

SOLARIZATION, MEZZOTINT, DUOTONE, ETC.: These are discouraged. There are a myriad of alteration "filters" available in digital photo software; please avoid them. They may be cool and fun, but they won't help you in this contest.

BLACK-AND-WHITE IMAGES: Acceptable

CROPPING: Acceptable

STITCHED PANORAMAS: NOT Acceptable

HIGH DYNAMIC RANGE (HDR) IMAGES: NOT Acceptable FISH-EYE LENSES: Unless used underwater, they are NOT acceptable. WATERMARKED IMAGES: NOT Acceptable

- 6. Only Photographs taken inside Bagalkot District will be permitted. It is mandatory to include the location, date and time of capture with your entry, if possible the GPS location too. Any photograph found to be taken outside Bagalkot District will be disqualified.
- 7. Photographs taken before the announcement of 'Capture Bagalkot' photography contest can be submitted.
- 8. No names or other indicators are allowed in or on the Entry that could indicate who is the author of the Entry.
- 9. Winning entrants must also be able to provide a high resolution digital file suitable for panel verification if required.
- 10. Each entry will be judged by the Panel of judges & their decisions will be final.
- 11. Your entries does not contain any false, misleading, abusive, harassing, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, scandalous, inflammatory and pornographic or violate any person's rights of privacy or publicity.
- 12. All images submitted by the entrants shall be solely owned by the respective entrants.
- 13. By registering for the Competition, the entrants grant unequivocal perpetual license to Catalytic Think Tank Forum, Bangalore to use the images submitted by the entrants for any purpose as Catalytic Think Tank Forum, Bangalore may deem fit, whether or not such purpose is for commercial gain.
