- Entry Format** : → Entries should be in images only.
→ Entries must be produced using any computerised art, design and production tool. (eg. Gimp, Illustrator, Photoshop etc.)
→ The format of the file should be JPEG / GIF / TIFF / PNG / BMP.
→ Max. 5 MB file size will be accepted.
- Theme/Subject** : “**Digital India**”
- Judging** : Famous cartoonist Sri Sumanta Baruah (www.sumantabaruah.com) has given consent to act as judge for the competition. His cartoons have been published in many magazines and journals and also exhibited in 3rd Rhodes International Cartoon Exhibition, Greece(2006) and International Cartoon Festival, Iran(2006). The decisions of the judges are final.

- Last Date** : **07-July-2015 upto 5:00PM**
- Prize Money** : Rs. 5,000/- for first winner plus certificate.
