- Authors will be invited to contribute a full-paper after an abstract of 500 words specifying the a) Purpose b)
   Design/methodology/approach c) Findings and d) Practical implications has been reviewed and accepted by the committee.
- All correspondence including the abstract and the full-paper must be e-mailed to octaphi@jqu.edu.in

#### **Formatting Requirements**

- The full-paper is to be around 3500 words. It includes the title (less than 10 words), abstract (500 words), six keywords, primary content, figures, tables, conclusions, acknowledgements, and a minimum of ten references in ONE DOCUMENT in MS Word (Compatibility mode).
- The paper must be written in past tense.
- Please use Times New Roman textual style; 16 point for title and 12 points for the content. All heading must be numbered serially and in bold, and the subheadings must be italicized.
- Leave a one (1) inch margin on all sides and justify contents to left and right margin.
- All information and exhibits/images, and references must be in APA format. Website references must include date of access.
- Check that paper prints correctly and completely, i.e. every single imported figure and tables are included in the submitted file).

### **Originality and Acknowledgement**

- Submissions must be of original quality; should not have been published or accepted in a journal or conference proceedings, nor presented at another conference.
- Submissions must not be concurrently under consideration for publication or presentation elsewhere.
- If the submitted paper is accepted, for presentation at the conference, the corresponding author (or in any event, one of the authors) must register for the conference and present the paper at the conference.

## **Additional Requirements**

- Authors need to provide full name, affiliation and contact details.
- The name of the corresponding author, if there are two or more authors of a paper, must be clearly indicated. All conference related information will be sent only to the corresponding author.
- Failure to comply with these requirements can result in removal of paper(s) from the proceedings.

#### **Awards**

- One "Best Paper Award" will be given to the author of a full-paper presented in each of the topic areas.
- One "Best Conference Paper Award" will be given to the author(s) of the best full-paper presented at the competition.
- The awards will be presented at the National Symposium on Supply Chain Management & Logistics being held on Saturday, February 27, 2016.

#### Registration Fees and Mode of Payment

- The Registration Fee of Rupees Nine Hundred (Rs.900/=) includes access to all sessions of the competition and meals at the presentation venue. However, the Registration fee excludes accommodation facility. Participants must make their own arrangements for stay during the conference.
